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## A. Role and Task of Volunteer

The volunteer will be placed in the primary structure of Gaziantep Training and Youth Association and partner associations. She will participate in training courses, projects, camps, debates, cultural events and civic education.

The objectives of the activity are:

- to reduce discrimination and raise voluntarism awareness in local community by performing a multinational project with orphans
- to give a framework for personal development and intercultural learning-by working and living within a team of different EVS volunteers
- to give to the volunteer a chance of initiative, creativity, and taking responsibilities in a multinational team
- to offer an alternative way of life and non-formal education ("place of reflection, action and experimentation")
- to experiment a large scale of "concrete " activities in the field of our manual and social project to stimulate self-confidence, autonomy and give a chance for new positive experiences.
- to raise European awareness and active citizenship by putting solidarity in concrete actions
- to learn to live together with other volunteers in the same apartment, with respect and tolerance towards the others and responsibility and autonomy for the common duties (cleaning, cooking etc.)
- to get new personal skills (art, language, organisation etc...)

The volunteer will participate in projects and activities like going outside with the students and volunteers, assist the organization on various festivals and activities, participate in national festivals, presenting the organization, and the culture.

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<b>B. Participation in "Volunteers for better generation 5"</b>
<p>Making EVS in « GEGED » coordination, the volunteer becomes an important part in the volunteers for a better generation 5 project. It means that apart from volunteer's main project in Gaziantep, Turkey, his/her mission will be also to promote EVS and to be active within this coordination. It means to take photos, write articles for newsletter, propose ideas for the community and for the project.</p> <p>Partner organizations has a right to use photos and videos taken by and/or with the participation of the volunteers in promotional and communicational aims, such as for the web pages, leaflets, newsletters, posters and so on.</p>
<b>C. Practical Arrangement</b>
<p><b>1. Volunteering Hours</b></p> <p>The volunteers will be active in the project for 35h per week (language lessons are the part of it. Arrival and departure days do not make the part of volunteering time.</p> <p>The volunteering schedule may also vary with time - some periods will be more busy, and some will be much more flexible. The planning of the activities the volunteer has to build up together with the host organisation.</p>
<p><b>2. Days off per week</b></p> <p>There are 2 days off per week, normally Saturday and Sunday. Sometimes, there will be activities also during the weekends, and it will be possible to recuperate these days afterwards during the week.</p>
<p><b>3. Holidays</b></p> <p>There are working 2 days off per month.</p> <p>Holiday period has to be agreed in advance with the hosting organisation.</p>
<p><b>4. Pocket money</b></p> <p>The volunteers will receive pocket money in the amount of 85 eur.</p>
<p><b>5. Accommodation and Food</b></p> <p>Host organisation will provide food and simple accommodation for the volunteer.</p> <p>The volunteer will be accommodated in a flat. The volunteer will share the common space and the bedroom. The flat is situated in the city and has 3 double bedrooms, kitchen, living room and all other facilities. There is PC and internet in the flat.</p>
<p><b>6. Local Transport</b></p> <p>As the flat is situated in the city centre there is no need to use public transportation.</p>
<p><b>7. Language lessons</b></p> <p>The language learning is an important thing in the frame of the EVS. GEGED org. will arrange the „language learning opportunities“.</p> <p>We provide one time per week a language lesson training for 2 hours and is for all the volunteers of the coordination. This training is not compulsory, just the volunteer needs to tell if he/she cannot participate in several sessions or do not wish to take the advantage of the trainings. There will be no courses for all levels, neither different schedules of the training. But surely the success of language learning will depend first of all on the volunteer's motivation.</p>
<b>D. Expected Learning Outcomes</b>
<p>European Volunteer Service is based on the principals of non-formal education. This gives learning opportunities outside schools, universities, and other similar institutions.</p> <p>Without doubts, the volunteer will learn a lot during your project, and sometimes about the things he/she could not even expect from the beginning. In order to make the volunteer's learning as efficient as possible, he/she has to take the responsibility for it, and to put clear aims, about what he/she wishes to learn, and how to achieve it.</p> <p>The volunteers will be supported in the following and evaluating their learning process that will result in a recognized at European level certificate Youthpass.</p> <p>We deeply wish to let this EVS place open for young people with a strong motivation to be a volunteer, and to continue after their EVS projects to be volunteers in their life and hopefully keep in touch with our organisation.</p> <p>The learning possibilities for the volunteer in this project are to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>· Learn the foreign language (or several languages)</li><li>· Approach the NGO sector and the work in international field</li><li>· Discover social programmes in France at local and national levels</li></ul>

## **E. All-sides agreement**

The volunteers are requested to read carefully all the above-mentioned conditions and in case if he/she do not fully agree with them - the best advice is not to start this project!

The "volunteers for a better generation 4" is a voluntary-based project, created by volunteers for volunteers with a real voluntary spirit.

If the volunteer from the very beginning is not happy with the existing rules and our very nice philosophy of the project, it will not be possible to start healthy collaboration and it will be frustrating for all the parties.

The EVS is a free will agreement of all the parties. In case if one of the parties (coordinating, hosting organisation or the volunteer) decide that the project does not have a sense, and that it goes in the wrong direction and does not correspond to the general EVS philosophy, the volunteer or the coordinating organisation has a right to stop the project.
