



If you don't have these, it's not a problem. You can add them any time. Career Coach can even help you create or refine your resume and LinkedIn profile.






Start your journey Open Career Coach

- 1. Go to Teams and select Career Coach.
- 2. Your **Office 365** account is used to sign in.



Note: Availability of app pinning is determined by your educational institution's IT department and may not be available.





- 1. Begin setting up your profile
 - On the Home page, select Get started.
 - Answer a few simple questions about your education and skills.
- 2. Add your resume or transcript
 - Select Profile and choose Skills Explorer.
 - Select Import file and upload your resume or transcript.
 - Add the **Document name** and **Document type**.
 - Select Upload and continue. Career Coach identifies the skills you have from your experience or courses you've taken and adds them to your profile.

Tip: To get resume help from Career Coach, select **Dashboard** > **Goals** > **Prepare to apply** and select the activity you need.
